During 2018, the ORC executive met ten times in addition to the fiscal year 2017 Annual General Meeting last spring. The meetings were typically two hours in length, with one longer meeting in November for debriefing the past year and planning for the upcoming season. Meetings were held in the ORC Boardroom during the warmer months and the office of Parkin Architects (made possible by Rob Boraks) in the winter.
