

The coordinator will oversee all Youth Day Camp operations, including the management of equipment, facilities, staff, and communication with registrants and their parents.

Along with the key responsibility of Youth Camp management, the Program Coordinator is responsible for fulfilling our civil duty as an inclusive community leader in recreation by interaction with a range of social groups in the Ottawa area to offer our **Everybody Rows Program, Lets Row Ottawa Program, Come Try Rowing Days** and our **Special Olympics Program**, which are free public offering designed to engage a diverse range of people with the sport of Rowing.
